Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Cloudy with a little rain or sleet across Scotland. Further wintry showers for eastern and south-eastern England, becoming increasingly confined to the southeast. Drier and brighter in the west. A brisk bitter wind developing across southern England. Feeling cold with a hard frost in the continued breeze across the south overnight.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Mostly dry with variable cloud and occasional sunny intervals. Some light snow flurries remain possible across southeast England on Friday. Cold, especially in the brisk wind across southern and south-eastern areas. Turning less cold from the north Saturday, with winds easing in the south. Some overnight frost and fog.
