Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Some bright spells are likely for western Scotland. Otherwise most places will be cloudy and very cold with snow at times. A covering of snow is likely in many places with the chance of some heavy falls in some locations, notably across the Pennines and for southeast England with drifting over higher ground in the strong northeasterly winds.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Very wintry with snow in many places, but brighter weather with scattered wintry showers will spread northwards across much of England on Tuesday. Further sleet or snow is likely in the north Wednesday with sunshine and scattered wintry showers likely further south.
