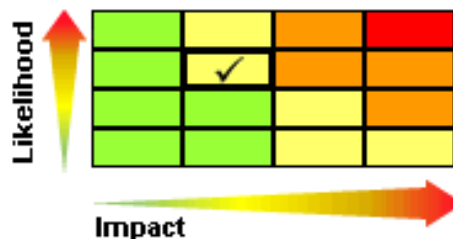
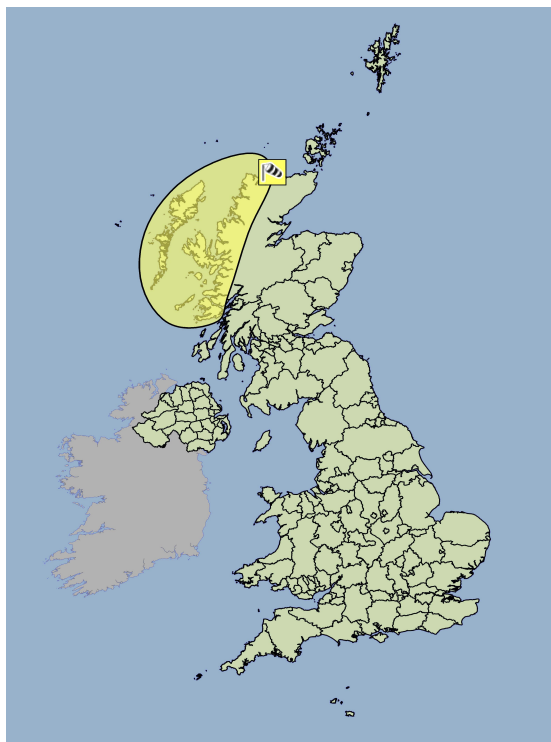




National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment

A deepening depression is expected to move northeastwards passing to the northwest of Scotland on Wednesday. This will bring a swathe of very strong winds with gusts of 60-70 mph.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Wind**

Valid from **11:00 on Wed, 09th Dec 2015** until **20:00 on Wed, 09th Dec 2015**

Southwesterly severe gales will develop across the northwest of the Scottish mainland and the Western Isles on Wednesday, with winds perhaps touching storm force in exposed areas during the afternoon.

Please be aware that some low level disruption to transport is expected and that the strong winds combined with persistent rain will give difficult traveling conditions. The winds will ease a little during the evening but will remain strong or gale force.
