Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Cold and cloudy today with outbreaks of light rain, perhaps turning to sleet or wet snow for a time. However for Northern Ireland and western Scotland there will be sunny spells and showers. Tonight, a few clear spells are possible, giving a risk of frost and ice.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Tomorrow looks to be a brighter day, and despite the cold, there will be some sunny spells. Some rain or sleet is possible, or perhaps the odd flurry of snow, but these will be brief and unlikely to settle. Monday will stay mostly dry and bright but with a risk of snow showers.
