Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
After a cloudy start it will become largely sunny across England and Wales and feel warm, away from the South Coast. Rain will move across Scotland with severe gales in the far northwest, but some brightness is possible in northeastern areas. Cloud and outbreaks of rain will continue very slowly southeastwards overnight, reaching northern England and Wales by morning.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Rain, sometimes heavy, will continue across parts of Northern Ireland, southern Scotland and northern England on Sunday. It will be dry, sunny and warm elsewhere, with winds easing too. A few spots of rain may spread to southern Britain on Monday.
