Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Northern Scotland will remain largely cloudy, near normal temperatures, and occasional light rain and drizzle, these conditions then probably extending across southeast Scotland and northeast England later today. Elsewhere dry and sunny, very warm or locally hot inland away from cooling coastal sea-breezes.

Overnight becoming cloudy across Scotland, and much of northeast England, with patchy light rain. Otherwise staying dry, mainly clear, with isolated mist and fog patches.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Sunday: Northern Ireland, Wales and southwest England dry and largely sunny. Elsewhere cloud will increase, bringing scattered showers. Locally hot again.

Monday: Mostly dry. Cloudy in the north, sunny spells further south.
