Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
Southern England, the Midlands and East Anglia, will have rain at times, especially southernmost counties, although the southwest should become clearer later.
Otherwise, South Wales will have light rain, while North Wales and northern England can expect bright intervals and just scattered showers. Meanwhile, Scotland and Northern Ireland will have sunny intervals and showers, particularly in western and northern regions, although with Shetland staying wet all day.
Countrywide, temperatures will be lower than today, although still very mild in the south.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:
Unsettled and turning much colder on Saturday when showers will turn wintry, especially in the north and east.
