Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Mostly dry and cloudy across England and Wales, with bright spells in far western parts, and fog patches in central and northern parts initially. Light rain is expected in Northern Ireland at first, and across northeast Scotland throughout the day. Staying cloudy overnight, with light winds and fog in places. Drizzle is possible, mainly in the east. Cold, locally frosty.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
Another cloudy day for many with outbreaks of drizzle, perhaps turning to light sleet or snow in the east. Bright or sunny spells possible in far western parts. Cloudy on Monday with a few snow showers, mainly in the east.
