Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Heavy and persistent rain will continue northwards into Scotland and parts of Northern Ireland during Saturday. It will also turn breezy along some exposed coasts. However it will be drier across southern parts during the morning, although there will be the risk of heavy afternoon showers. The warmest temperatures are likely across eastern England.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Heavy rain in the north will gradually clear on Sunday, to be replaced by drier and brighter weather spreading up from the south. Some afternoon sunny intervals are likely, during which it will feel warm. Monday will then see further scattered showers and some sunny spells.
