Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Thursday:-Cloudy with rain or snow in far north moving away north.  
Mostly dry with sunny spells, especially across northern and eastern  
areas. Rain reaching Cornwall later. Becoming windy in southwest.  
Rather cold.

Thursday evening:-Mostly dry and clear at first, northeast remaining  
dry until dawn. Rain across southwest extending across most areas.  
Some heavy and falling as sleet or snow over Scotland and higher  
parts of northern England. Becoming windy generally.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Unsettled. Outbreaks of rain on Friday, some heavy, with snow in far  
north. Sunny spells and showers on Saturday, with further rain  
spreading into west later. Windy. Milder for most.
