Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Scotland will be cold and windy with showers in the north, wintry on hills.
Elsewhere, early fog and frost will clear in the morning and thereafter, it will
be dry and sunny in many places, perhaps more cloudy at times in the south.
Winds will be mainly light northerly, though stronger over northern Scotland.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Any early mist will soon clear on Tuesday, then fine and sunny, apart from
wintry showers over northern Scotland. Sleet and snow will reach Cornwall
overnight, then spread slowly to all districts by late Thursday and turning to
rain. Southeasterly winds will strengthen.
