Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain across northwest Wales and northwest England will be heavy at times over the hills. Elsewhere, mostly dry and warm with sunny spells but southwestern coasts may see a little drizzle and a few showers will affect the far north. The rain will move north into N.Ireland and Scotland overnight. A mainly dry and humid night over England and Wales.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Some heavy rain for a time in the north and west on Sunday with other parts mostly dry and very warm and humid. Sunny spells for most on Monday but also with some showers which may be heavy in places.
