Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Rain in Northern Ireland, Wales and southwest England will quickly move across Scotland and England through the morning, clearing by the afternoon. Then, bright and breezy with scattered, sharp showers, mostly easing through the evening, although continuing in the northwest. Heavy, persistent rain will spread into Wales and western England overnight.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Persistent rain in the south may turn to sleet or snow on the back edge as it becomes confined to eastern England. Blustery, wintry showers will continue further north. A wet start to Monday in the southeast, with a risk of some snow. Bright elsewhere with isolated wintry showers.
