Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:

A cold start with the risk of some icy stretches in the southeast and perhaps too in parts of the northeast. Wintry showers in the far southeast will gradually clear through the day. Otherwise mainly dry, bright and chilly, with just the odd isolated wintry shower possible. Brisk winds in the south will start to ease later.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

A dry and bright weekend for most with some good spells of sunshine, especially towards the west. Feeling less cold than of late by day with lighter winds, though still nighttime frosts. A few wintry showers possible in northern Scotland.
