

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Tuesday 04 Jan 2011

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Wet and breezy in Northern Ireland, Scotland and northern England, with rain and hill snow possible during the day, giving icy surfaces at first. Further south, rain showers are likely, especially for Wales and western England. Overnight, becoming wet across the country, with spells of hill snow continuing for Scotland and northern England.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Wet on Wednesday, with spells of rain across the country and hill snow towards the north. Perhaps some brightness developing in northwest parts later, with winds easing. On Thursday, generally dry and bright, but with blustery snow showers into northern parts, and with rain in the south.
