Headline:

Becoming wet and windy after bright start in the east.

Today:

A bright start in the east, but thickening cloud bringing organised rain eastwards, this becoming heavy and prolonged over western hills. Feeling cool and becoming rather windy.

Tonight:

Rain persisting across southern areas, elsewhere turning clearer, but still with blustery showers. Mild in the south.

Outlook for Friday:

Rain clearing the southeast, then sunshine and squally showers accompanied by gusty northwesterly gales. Feeling chilly.
