Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Apart from a few light showers around coasts and down eastern parts of Scotland and England, many places will have a fine and dry day with good spells of sunshine. There will be a cool wind but in shelter it should feel quite pleasant in the sunshine.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

A cloudy and windy day everywhere with rain and drizzle, especially in the north where it will be heavy over hills. In sheltered parts of England and Wales the cloud will thin and break allowing some afternoon sunshine to develop. Staying bright and breezy on Tuesday with rain for Scotland and Northern Ireland.
