Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain will slowly clear southeastern England but it will stay fairly cloudy for much of the day here. There will be plenty of sunshine elsewhere, with scattered blustery showers, heaviest and most frequent in the northwest and falling as snow on Scottish mountains. Showers will continue in many places overnight but eastern Britain will be drier, clearer and colder.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Sunny spells and scattered, blustery showers will continue on Friday, again giving snow over Scottish hills. Eastern parts of the UK will see the best of the sunshine. Showery outbreaks of rain will affect many parts of the UK on Saturday.
