Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Any freezing fog will clear most parts by lunchtime, joining the majority of the UK in a mainly dry and sunny day. However, there is a risk of wintry showers towards coasts exposed to the north in Scotland and England, moving inland in parts to give some localised snow. Feeling very cold, with a northerly breeze developing by the afternoon.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:  
Becoming less cold and increasingly cloudy from the northwest, with frosts gradually becoming less severe. Most parts staying mainly dry, but outbreaks of rain will affect some places, especially north-facing coasts. The best bright spells should appear towards the south.
