Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Cloudy with showers or occasional light rain, but gradually becoming
brighter and drier during today, especially away from the east coast.
Windy in the west this morning. Temperatures around normal.
Mainly dry and cold with frost and some fog patches tonight. A few
evening showers dying out overnight.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Mostly fine with sunny spells on Monday, apart from some persistent
fog patches. Cloudy, wet and quite windy conditions will spread
southeast across Scotland and N.Ireland. The wet weather will push
southeast across the whole UK on Tuesday with sunny spells and
scattered showers following to most parts. Temperatures around
normal.
