

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 1945 on Friday 08 May 2015

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Early cloud and patchy rain will gradually clear east, leaving sunny intervals and scattered showers by afternoon. Showers will mostly become confined to eastern areas, perhaps locally heavy with thunder. Winds will be light and it will feel warm towards the southeast as sunshine develops.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

After a bright start in eastern areas on Sunday, cloud elsewhere will continue to spread eastwards to leave most areas rather dull by midday. Rain will affect some western parts, heaviest in the far northwest with strong winds. Rain will then edge slowly southeastwards during Monday, whilst the southeast remains dry with some warm sunshine.
