General Situation

A chilly and showery northerly airflow has become established between low pressure in the east, and high pressure over the Atlantic. Weak weather fronts will bring rain for northern Scotland later on Thursday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northwesterly 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later in east.

Slight or moderate at first in southeast, otherwise rough or very rough.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North, backing west or northwest later, 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very in rough at first in north, occasionally slight later in Moray Firth.

Showers, occasional rain or drizzle later in north.

Good, occasionally moderate later in north.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northwesterly 4 to 6, occasionally 7 later in north.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later, occasionally very rough later near Rattray Head.

Showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly backing westerly later, 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first, then decreasing 4 at times later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first near Rattray Head, becoming slight later in Firth of Clyde.

Showers, becoming fair later.

24 hour forecast:

North or northwest 4 to 6, occasionally 7 later.

Slight becoming moderate, then rough later.

Showers, becoming fair later.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate or rough later.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

Slight in east, moderate or rough in west.
Showers in west.

Northerly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times in west.
Moderate or rough west of the Lizard peninsula, otherwise slight or moderate.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northwesterly 4 to 6, occasionally 7 in west.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in west.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 4 to 6, occasionally at first 7 in west, decreasing 4 at times in the Bristol Channel.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in southwest.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4 at first in Cardigan Bay, otherwise northerly or northeasterly 4 to 6, occasionally 7 in west.

Slight or moderate.

Northerly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first in west, then decreasing 4 at times later.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

Variable 3 or 4 at first in Liverpool Bay, otherwise northerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in west.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in west.

Northerly backing northwesterly later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in west.

Slight or moderate, becoming slight later near Solway Firth.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

Northerly 4 to 6.

Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate.

Northerly 4 to 6, backing northwesterly 3 to 5 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first in the North Channel.

Showers at first.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North 5 or 6, occasionally 4 in shelter.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in shelter.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North backing northwest later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in west.

Showers at first.

Good.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northwest 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough, occasionally very rough later near northern entrance.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North backing west or northwest, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first near northern entrance and slight in south.

Showers, occasional drizzle later.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northwest 5 or 6.

Rough or very rough.

Showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North backing west or northwest, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.

Rough or very rough at first in north, otherwise moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate later in south.

Showers, occasional drizzle later.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A showery northwesterly flow will cover Shetland waters. Shallow low pressure area will drift southwards to the east of Shetland during Wednesday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil at time of issue.

Northwest 4 or 5 increasing 6 or 7

Moderate or rough. becoming rough or very rough. remaining moderate in sheltered southeastern waters.

Showers

Good, occasionally moderate or poor

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Wednesday 03 Nov until 0000 UTC on Thursday 04 Nov:

Northwesterly 6 or 7, perhaps gale 8 in north

Rough or very rough, occasionally high in north. moderate in sheltered southeastern waters at first

Showers

Good, occasionally moderate or poor

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Northerly 3 to 4, locally variable 1 to 2 at times, becoming 4 to 5 later.

Smooth to slight with a low swell, becoming slight locally moderate later.

Occasional showers, locally heavy, with a risk of hail and thunder.

Good, occasionally moderate, locally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 4 to 5, locally 6 at times.

Moderate, occasionally slight with a low swell.

Occasional showers, locally heavy with a risk of hail and thunder at first, becoming isolated Thursday morning.

Good, occasionally moderate, locally poor at first.

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
