Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
England and Wales should have bright intervals but cloud will generally increase and there may be a few patches of light rain in the west and south. Scotland and Northern Ireland will also have a good deal of cloud and rain will affect northern and western Scotland and parts of Northern Ireland. Windy, gales in parts of the north but temperatures several degrees above normal.
Many parts dry tonight but windy, rain in the far northwest.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:
A good deal of dry weather but rain will edge across from the west later in Wednesday and die out on Thursday.
