Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Hot and sunny in southeastern parts of the UK, but wet, relatively cool and breezy for much of Scotland and Northern Ireland. Otherwise, a good deal of warm and bright weather, but mist may linger around some western coasts. Tonight, some patchy rain in the west, and chance of a few showers in the southeast later.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

A cloudy start for many on Friday, then bright and breezy with sunny spells and scattered showers. Some of the showers heavy and possibly thundery. Still warm in the east, fresher elsewhere. On Saturday, bright and breezy with scattered showers, especially towards the west.
