Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Cloud and rain over Scotland and N.Ireland initially will slowly move across northern England and Wales during Sunday. Otherwise largely dry with sunny spells. Very warm, locally hot in the southeast, but fresher in the northwest behind that rain band.
Cloudy, muggy conditions with occasional rain will push southeastwards across England and Wales tonight. Cooler, mainly dry weather and clear spells will follow from the northwest.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:
Rain slowly clearing southeast England on Monday. Mainly dry with sunny spells elsewhere. Largely dry with sunny spells on Tuesday too, but rain will push into Scotland and N.Ireland later on. Temperatures around normal.
