Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Low cloud and misty conditions over eastern parts of Scotland and northeast England. Sunny spells and scattered heavy showers and thunderstorms over southwest and central-southern England and southern Wales. Many other parts of Britain dry, with long sunny periods over central and southeastern parts where it will be hot. Scattered showers and thunderstorms developing inland during the afternoon and evening, merging into longer spells of heavy rain overnight.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Thundery showers affecting many parts on Wednesday, persistent and locally torrential over southern Britain. A few showers over eastern parts on Thursday but becoming drier, brighter and fresher from the west later.
