

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
It will be a fairly cloudy start with sunshine and scattered showers soon developing. Some showers could be heavy across eastern parts of England but should clear in the afternoon before cloud and rain spreads in from the west overnight. However, southern and southeastern parts of England should stay mainly dry. Southwesterly winds will be light.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Wind and rain will continue over much of England and Wales during Friday but it should be mainly dry for southeast England. It will also become brighter across Scotland and Northern Ireland. Most parts will remain unsettled on Saturday, with rain eventually clearing southeastwards.
