

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Monday 22 Jul 2013

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Cloud and mist in the northeast will gradually burn away, with sunny spells developing across the UK. It will then become hot and humid, especially in the southeast. This will help fuel isolated thundery downpours, initially for England and Wales, before spreading erratically northeastwards overnight. A very warm and muggy night follows, with further thunderstorms pushing in from the southwest.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Another very warm and humid day on Tuesday, as heavy showers spread northeastwards. These bring the risk of thunderstorms, hail and gusty winds. Further heavy showers then follow on Wednesday. Feeling less hot than recently, but still warm in sunshine.
