Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Outbreaks of rain across northwestern parts of the UK will sink slowly southeastwards throughout the day and overnight, being replaced by clearer conditions across the far northwest, but with a few showers here. Southeast England however will see warm sunny spells by day and, although there will be a risk of showers overnight, many parts will stay dry.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Outbreaks of rain should slowly clear from eastern England on Sunday, but will be replaced by further spells of rain from the west. Monday will see a mixture of sunshine and showers, some of which are likely to be heavy and thundery.
