

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Sunday 07 Oct 2012

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Starting cold, with local fog patches gradually lifting. Otherwise fine and dry for most throughout, with long sunny spells. Southwestern Britain will become cloudier during the afternoon, with winds strengthening ahead of rain later. Overnight, northern and eastern UK will be clear and cold, with fog patches and local rural frost. Meanwhile, southwestern parts will be cloudier with occasional rain.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Conditions will remain similar on both days, with southern England and Wales mainly cloudy with spells of rain. Northern UK will be drier and brighter once again, after cold starts and early fog patches, with further lengthy spells of sunshine.
