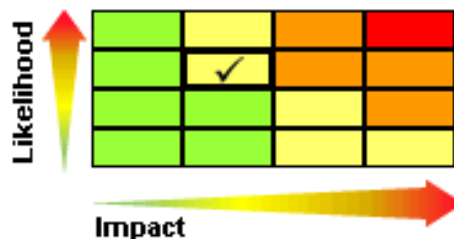

Although wintry showers will be more frequent in the north and west, the strong westerly winds will push some of these across to the east as well. While many of the showers at low levels will be of rain or sleet this will increase the risk of ice on untreated surfaces. On higher ground in the north an additional 2 to 5cm of snowfall is likely.
