Headline:

Light rain and snow fizzling out, cold in southeast.

Today:

An area of rain and snow in central Britain will move southeastwards decaying slowly but southeast England should stay dry and cold. To the north, brighter but rather cloudy.

Tonight:

Many parts dry, misty with fog patches and pockets of frost.

Outlook for Sunday:

Dry and bright for many parts after early fog clears but rain spreading to northern and some western parts.
