

**Icy patches in the east may give difficult driving conditions overnight and Thursday morning.**

What to expect

- Some injuries from slips and falls on icy surfaces
- Probably some icy patches on some untreated roads, pavements and cycle paths

**Further details**

Scattered showers will affect much of the east coast of Scotland this evening and overnight, falling onto freezing surfaces. These will be heavy at times and will lead to a risk of icy surfaces where any treatment is washed off. Showers will be wintery above 200m away from the coast across Aberdeenshire and Moray, with 1-2cm of snow possible.
