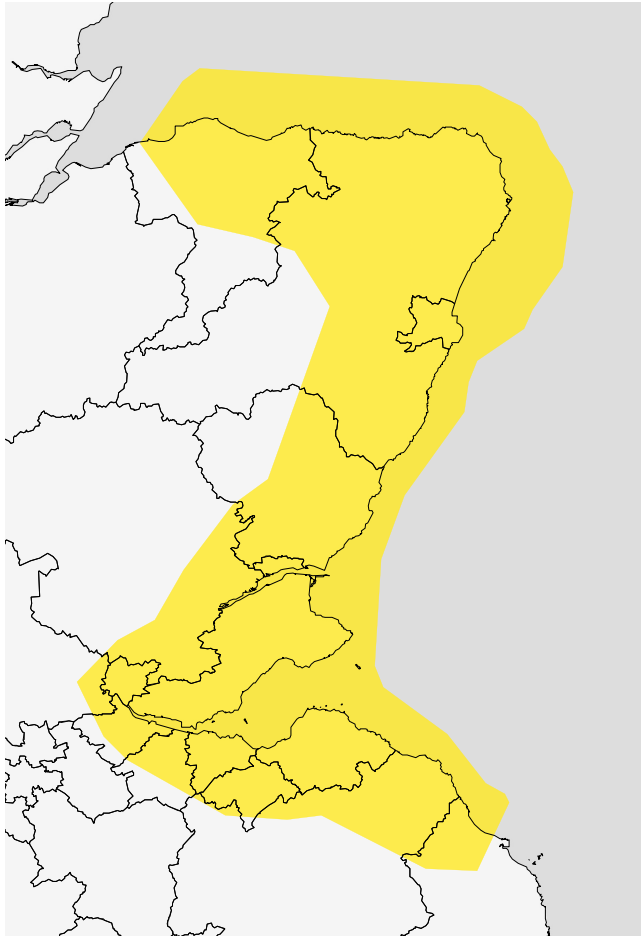

**What to expect**

- Some injuries from slips and falls on icy surfaces
- Probably some icy patches on some untreated roads, pavements and cycle paths

## Further details

Scattered showers will affect much of the east coast of Scotland this evening and overnight, falling onto freezing surfaces. These will be heavy at times and will lead to a risk of icy surfaces where any treatment is washed off. Showers will be wintry above 200m away from the coast across Aberdeenshire and Moray, with 1-2cm of snow possible.
