

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
A cold, frosty start in central and southeastern areas but cloudy with rain in the north and west. This rain moves eastwards across the country today, turning heavy in places. Snow is expected in parts of central and eastern Scotland. Becoming dry and clear from the west later, but showers continuing in the northwest overnight.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Much drier and brighter on Tuesday, although with a few showers, mainly in the north and west. Becoming cloudier from the west later, with rain crossing the country overnight. Mainly cloudy and mild on Wednesday, with occasional rain or drizzle and brisk westerly winds.
