Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:

Rain, with sleet and snow over high ground, will persist across central Scotland and parts of Northern Ireland. To the south it will be brighter with sunny spells, but with frequent, heavy and blustery showers in western areas spreading east to affect many places during the day.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Wednesday will be a drier day for many, with lighter winds and sunny periods. On Thursday, rather wet and windy across many northern areas at first, but with the rain generally moving away eastwards. Southern areas are likely to stay mostly cloudy, mild and damp after a wet start in the east.
