Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Severe gales are expected across the Northern Isles at first. Otherwise a cool, bright day for many but showers affecting northern and western parts of the country, with snow across the Northern Isles later. Southern England will be cloudier with rain at times, this turning heavy across southeastern England overnight. Most other areas will be largely dry, cold and frosty.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

A cold start for many on Friday with plenty of sunshine for England and Wales. However, rain and strong winds across the northwest of the country will gradually spread southeast, affecting most parts overnight. Rain will clear during Saturday, though.
