Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Most places will have a dull and misty day with some occasional light drizzle from time to time mainly on the hills where it will also be foggy at times. However, western areas should be brighter with a little sunshine in places, particularly northwest Scotland; and it should be fairly mild.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:
Another dull and rather damp day on Thursday with some drizzle or rain moving northwards across eastern areas. Further rain will arrive in the southwest by evening, but in between this it should be dry with perhaps some brightness. Many places will see rain or showers on Friday.
