Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Rain, some of it heavy and prolonged, will spread northeast, clearing most of England and Wales by mid-afternoon, but lingering across Scotland and northeast England into the evening and night. Showers following from the west, heavy and locally thundery, but also sunny spells. Rain continuing in Shetland tonight, showers in many western areas, especially northwest Scotland and across southwestern regions. It will be mild, but still very windy.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:  
There will be some sunshine Friday, but further scattered showers in the west. On Saturday, changeable with rain or showers, just a few brief sunnier interludes. Remaining windy with average temperatures.
