Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Friday:-Many places starting dry with sunny spells. However, showers already affecting NW.Scotland becoming more widespread across rest of Scotland/N.Ireland, and parts of N.England. The showers again locally heavy/thundery. Remaining parts of England/Wales staying mostly dry, a few sharp showers developing, mainly E.Anglia/SE.England. Temperatures mostly around normal, locally warm in the east. Breezy.  
Friday evening/night:-Rather cloudy in the north/northwest, showers continuing to affect areas exposed to the northwesterly wind. Dry with some clear periods elsewhere.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:  
Cloudy in north, with some rain/showers. Mostly dry in south, with sunny spells, risk of some showers on Saturday. Warm, but very warm in sunnier spots.
