

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Occasionally heavy rain across northern England, Northern Ireland, Wales and southern and central Scotland turning to snow in places for awhile. This rain is expected to largely peter out early in the afternoon, with somewhat brighter but colder conditions spreading east to many parts. Strong to gale southwesterly winds across England and Wales easing later.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

A frosty start Tuesday, with fog in places, but bright with sunny spells for most parts. However, cloud and rain is likely to reach the far southwest later. A return to generally breezy, cloudy conditions, with rain in places, is expected Wednesday.
