Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Icy patches in the north at first. Most places dry with sunny periods, but still a few well scattered showers in the north, and in the southeast at first. Cloud will thicken from the southwest during the afternoon and evening. Brisk northwesterly winds will gradually ease through the day.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Rain and strong winds will spread to northern Britain on Thursday, the rain becoming heavy over western Scotland. Southern Britain will be cloudy, mild and drier. On Friday the rain and gales becoming confined to northwest Scotland, most other areas cloudy, mild, but still rather windy.
