Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
Most places will start very frosty with one or two freezing fog patches, but these will clear, then most places will have sunny periods. However, snow showers, already around many northern coasts will extend southwards down some western and eastern coasts with a few developing inland. There will be heavy falls of snow in places, especially for northern Scotland. Southern England will be cloudier, perhaps with some longer spells of snow, but this should clear away southwards later. It will remain cold.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

It will remain cold with overnight frost and sunshine by day. There will be further snow showers too, especially in the north and east, along with exposed parts of the west.
