

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Heavy rain with a risk of hail and squally winds clearing southwards. Sunshine and showers following with snow mostly over hills, but a risk of ice first thing in the north. Windy and feeling cold. Tonight, further showers, most frequent in the east with some hail and hill snow. Isolated frost and ice in the west later.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Thursday, rather cold and windy with sunny spells and showers, these becoming more confined to eastern and southeastern coasts. Winds lessening, but remaining breezy in the southeast. Friday, many places dry and bright, but the southeast will remain cloudy and breezy with showers.
