Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Frequent showers across northern Scotland through the morning with strong to gale force winds over the north at first. Otherwise, mostly dry with some sunshine, while scattered showers die out through the morning. Cloud will thicken in the northwest again later, bringing further patchy rain. Continuing mild and the strong winds gradually easing.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Rain spreading east across all parts on Friday morning followed by sunny spells and scattered showers over the northwest. A spell of heavier rain across southern areas during Saturday. The showers across northern parts will give way to more persistent rain later. Mild with increasing winds.
