Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
A cooler day than of late for most. A band of rain affecting Northern Ireland and the far west of Britain at dawn will steadily move eastwards, with very warm and sunny conditions becoming increasingly confined to East Anglia and parts of southeastern England. Fresher but showery conditions will follow the rain into western parts, with some late sunshine here.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Unsettled, with temperatures falling to near or perhaps a little below average for July across the UK. Sunny intervals will be interrupted by occasionally heavy showers countrywide, with longer spells of rain more likely towards the north and west throughout.
