Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Rain will continue to linger in the far southeast, though it should turn drier here though the afternoon. Brighter elsewhere with a few showers in the west, locally heavy. Tonight will be very wet and windy. Heavy rain and gale or severe-gale force winds are expected with some damaging gusts in exposed parts of the Southwest, Wales and around the Irish-sea in particular.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Early rain on Sunday will clear the southeast with blustery showers following to all parts, heavy and prolonged at times in the north. Very windy with severe gales in places. More rain will spread north during Monday.
