Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Most areas will see sunny spells and showers, some of these heavy and prolonged, locally wintry over high ground in the north. It will be a very windy day with gales, however the severe gales affecting Wales at first will gradually ease. Showers will persist in the west overnight, tending to merge across southwestern areas by morning.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Northern Scotland may be fine and dry on Tuesday, but rain, locally heavy, will spread northeastwards across all other parts. Wednesday should be drier and brighter for many, with some sunny spells, but showers affecting Scotland and southern England. Gales at times.
