Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Sunny intervals and scattered showers once again. Some heavy across western parts of England during the morning, transferring to central and southeastern areas by the afternoon. Showers easing overnight, but some continuing across southern parts of England and Wales. Clear spells will develop, making it feel chilly across northern rural areas by dawn.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Dry and bright for most, but perhaps the odd shower developing over southern England and Wales on Saturday. Cloud and wind increasing across the far east during Saturday afternoon, with rain arriving by the evening. Continuing to be wet and windy along the eastern coast through Sunday.
