Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for Christmas Day :
Overnight frost and fog patches will be slow to clear with a few patches lingering all day. In areas affected it will stay cold. But for much of the UK a dry and bright Christmas Day is expected with some sunshine and afternoon temperatures close to normal in light winds. However the evening will quickly become cold with frost and patchy fog returning.

Outlook for Boxing Day and Tuesday:
Western areas of the UK mostly dry, cold, some sunshine, but frosty overnight. Central and eastern areas will become cloudier and very cold with snow showers, some of these heavy especially across east and southeast England.
